

What is a "precinct?"

Smallest administrative electoral unit

- Also known as 'Electoral Districts', 'Towns' or 'Wards'
- All voters have the same ballot
 - Have a set number of voters
 Have continuous boundaries
- and elected officials



Types of precinct organizing

Type 1: Campaign

- Short term: June through
 November of election years
- Organized by campaign staff
- Focused on winning a particular election
- Centered around a candidate

Type 2: Neighborhood

- Long term: Not limited by election calendar
- Focused on long range goals
- Organized by local volunteers

Strengths

- 1. Professionally staffed
- 2. Controlled message
- 3. Access to campaign resources

- 3. Access to community resources





- Social Chair




