


The Proverbial Sports Analogy

The Numbers

Across all elected bodies in the U.S.:

- **★** 90% of elected officials are white
- **★** 65% of elected officials are white men

Case Study - District Attorneys:

- **★** Nationwide (est. 2016): 95% of District Attorneys are white
- **★** California:
 - **★** White = 38.5% population and 70% of the state's District Attorneys
 - **★** Latinx/Hispanic = 38.8% population and 9.4% of the state's District Attorneys



The Numbers: Campaigns

- **★** 2010 2012 cycle
 - **★** \$514 million to political consultants
 - **★** 97% of those dollars went to white consultants and businesses
 - * 83% of it to white men
- **★** 2014 cycle
 - **★** \$193 million to political consultants
 - **★** 97.9% went to white-led consultant firms





Turnout Matters

If 2016 voter turnout in Milwaukee, Detroit, and Philadelphia MATCHED their turnout in 2012, Hillary Clinton would have won.





The Keith Ellison Difference

Statewide turnout in Minnesota decreased by 5% from 2010 to 2014.

Turnout INCREASED by 3% in Keith Ellison's district over the same period.

Keith's was the only district in Minnesota where voter turnout GREW between 2010 and 2014.




Prioritize Organizing

Prioritize and invest in organizing — conversation-based voter contact — early and consistently.









Build Inclusive Voter Targeting Models

Prioritize and invest in organizing and tactics that expand the electorate and welcome in newer voters.



Invest Down Ballot

There's no off-year — invest in local elections now to build a successful 50 state strategy.



Center People of Color

Center and invest in and trust the leadership of people of color.




Values
